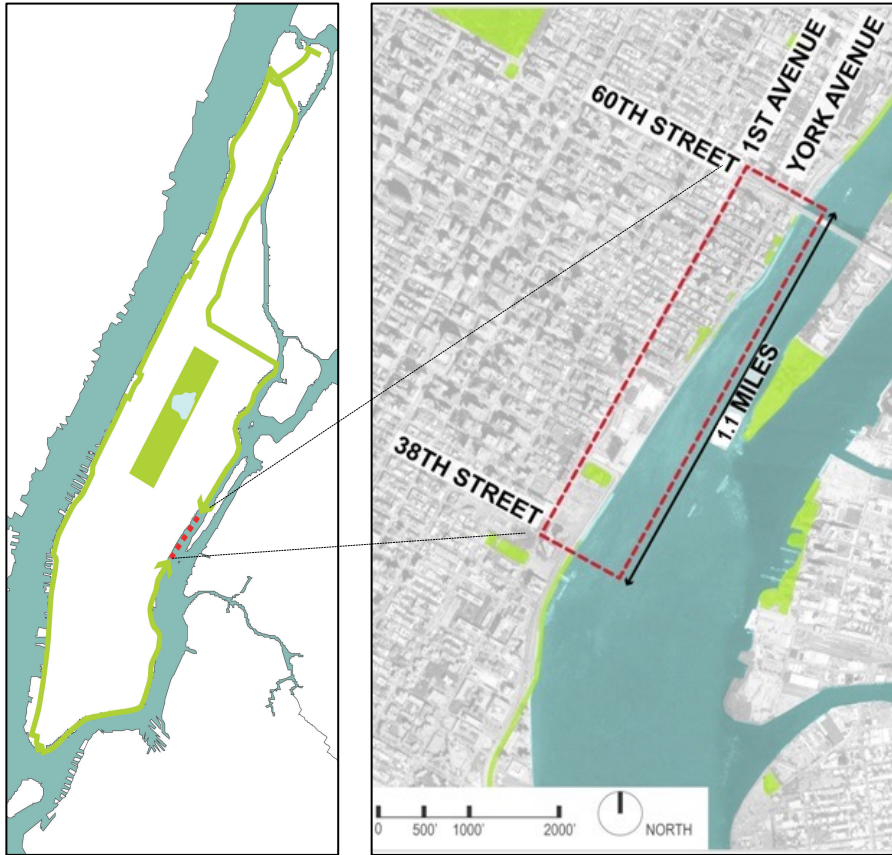

Project Background

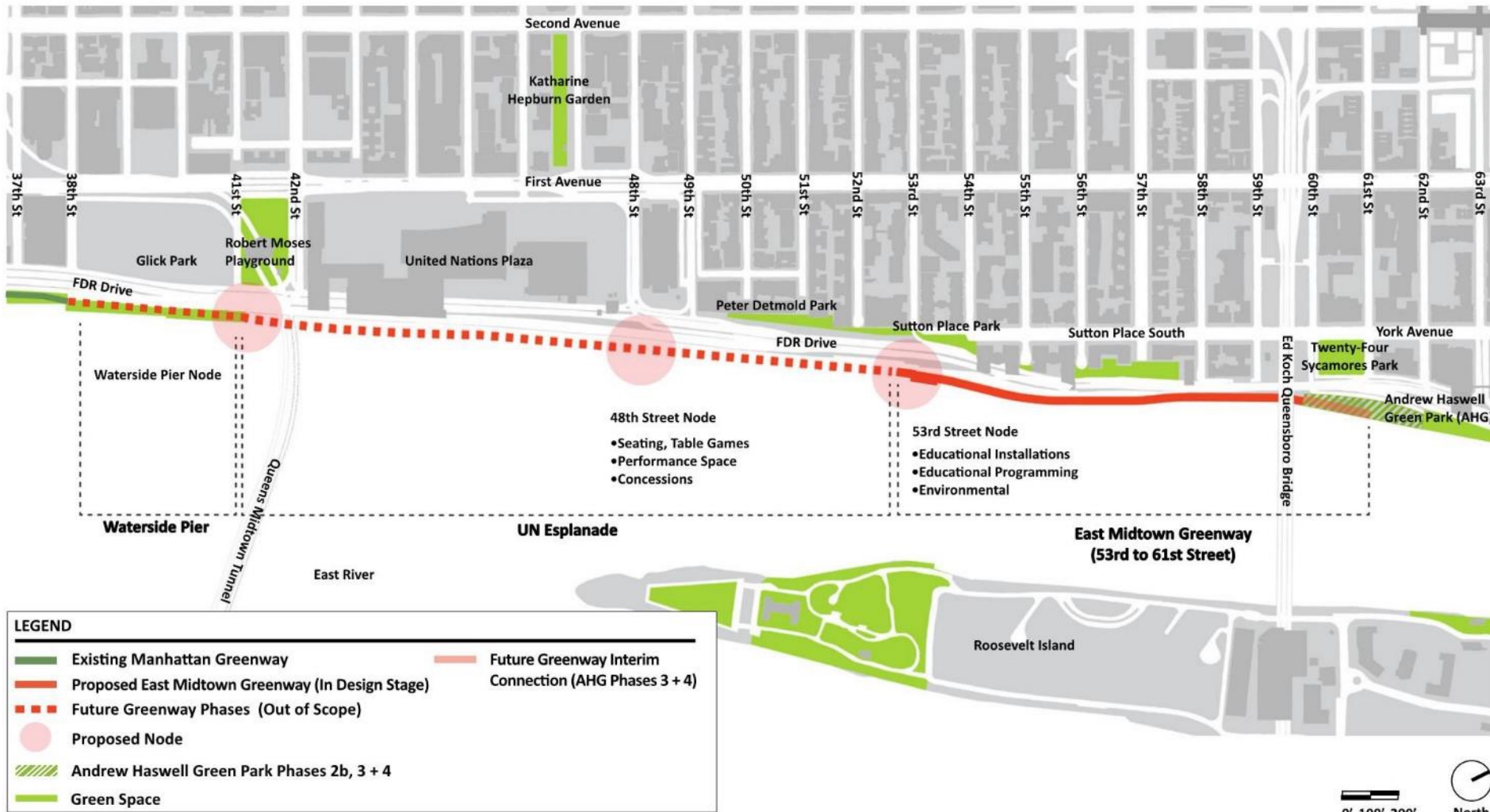
East Midtown Waterfront project, conceived in 2012, aimed to close a 1.1 mile gap in the Manhattan Greenway.










Goals

- Provide a continuous esplanade along the East River
- Provide critical transportation connections
- Provide new open space to alleviate chronic shortage in Midtown East

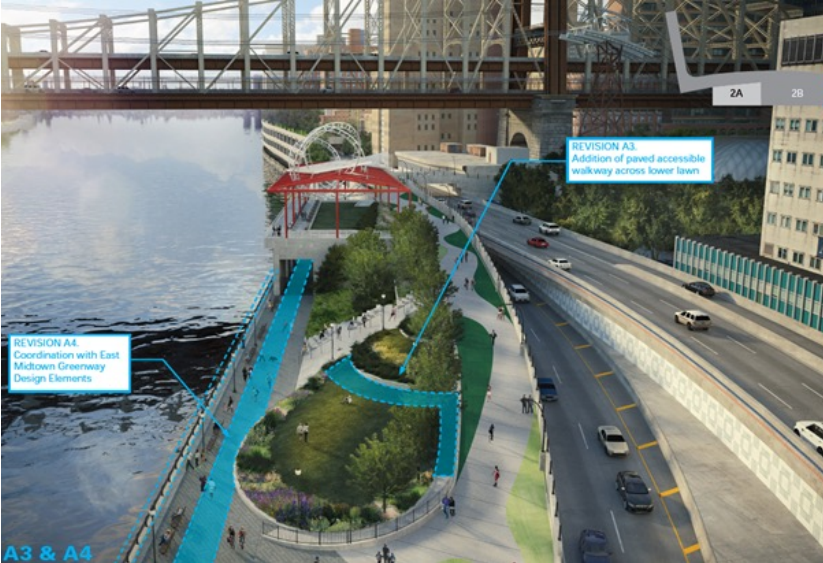

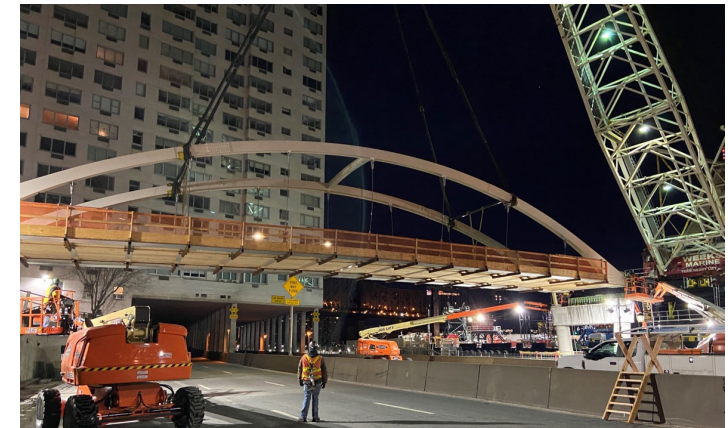

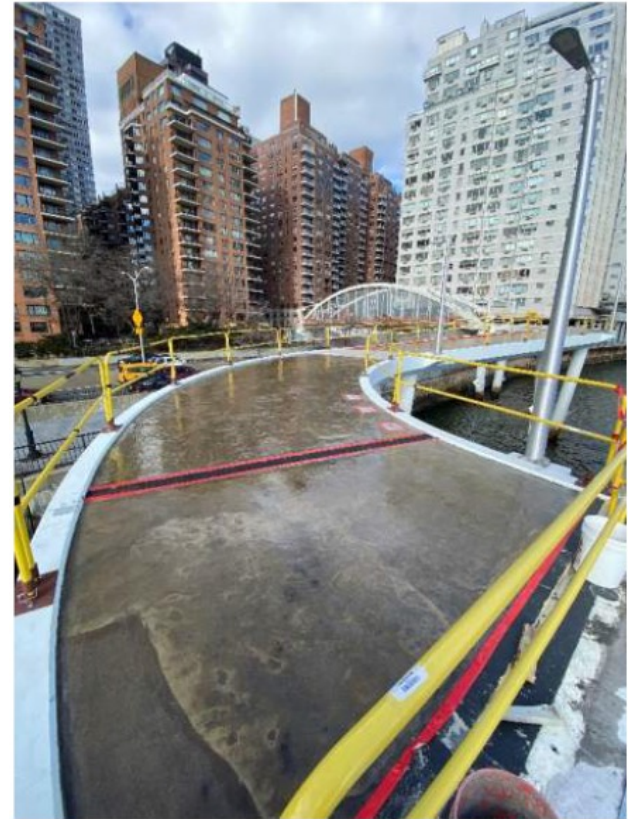
