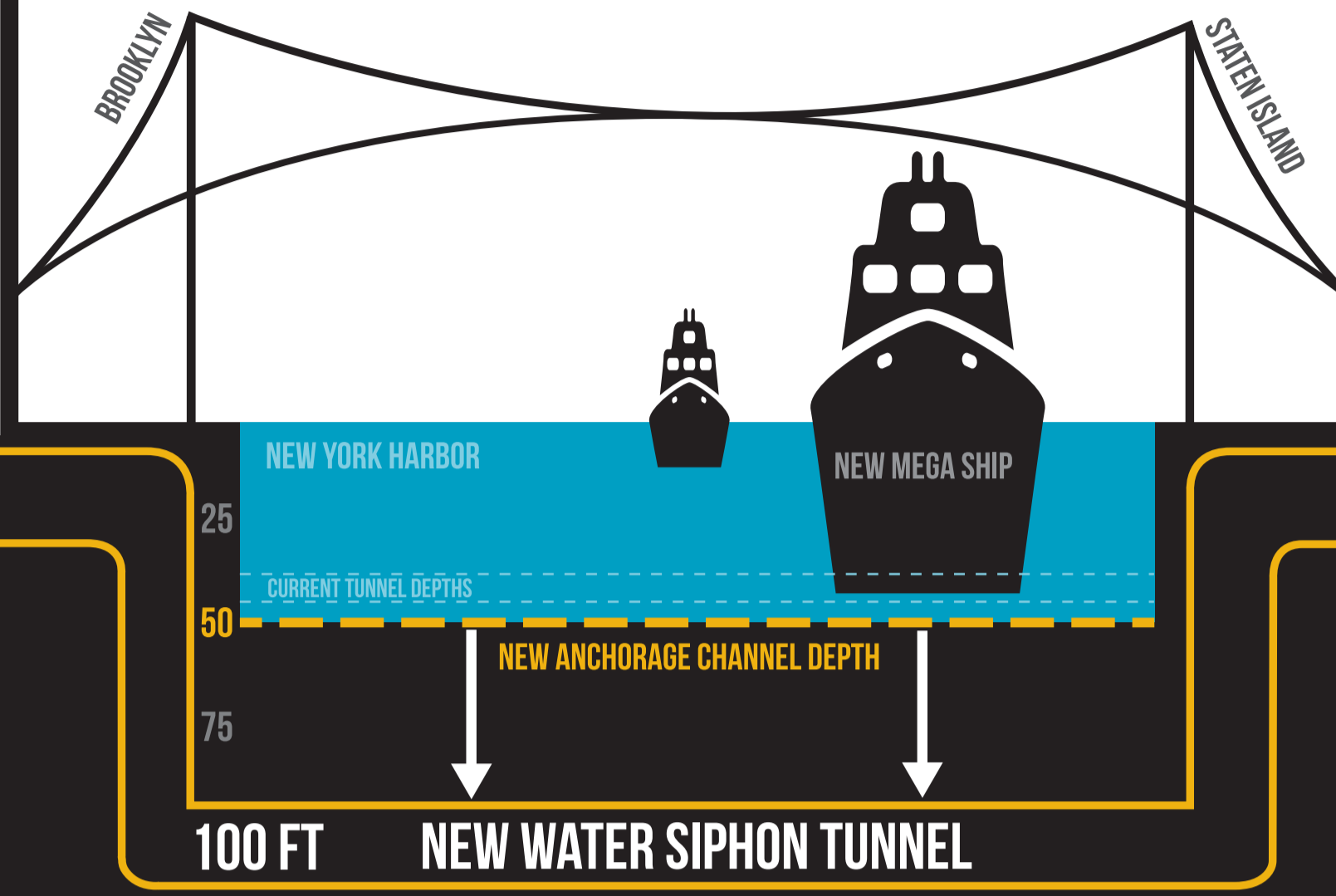


THE BIGGEST NYC INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT YOU HAVEN'T HEARD OF

The Staten Island Siphon Project will accomplish two major goals:

- Provide a secure back-up water supply to residents of Staten Island, replacing two outdated existing siphons.
- Allow for the deepening of Anchorage Channel, one of the New York Harbor's busiest waterways, so that it can accommodate new cargo mega-ships and help boost the shipping trade.

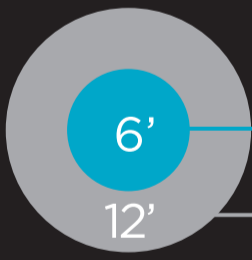
